

Dear parents and caregivers,

To support the BYOD MyPad program, the school uses Microsoft Intune. Intune provides the ability to enrol student devices and applications onto the department network. By using Intune, Pacific Pines Primary School has committed to purchasing all apps across our school for students in Prep to Grade 6. This saves our families over \$50 per student per year on app purchases.

What are the main services provided by Intune?

- User authentication services to gain access to a school network
- Through Microsoft Intune:
 - o device configuration and enablement from home
 - o promotion of school applications and websites
 - certificate provisioning for Wi-Fi access
- Through guest Wi-Fi the ability to grant:
 - students' ability to on-board their devices at school if required

What Intune does

This software enables mobile configuration settings to be deployed to devices to:

- Enable Wi-Fi Connectivity to the school's network
- Enable automatic setup of the device's default email application to add the student's departmental email account
- Enable access to a school selected list of app store applications

What's next

- Please familiarise yourself with the user guides for getting your child's iPad ready for school
- Students will be signing the MyPad User Agreement with their classroom teacher (a copy of this is attached for your information)
- Intune guidelines and instructions are attached, please install the software as instructed
- Students will begin using iPads for learning in Week 2, Term 1 (Years 1 6) and Week 3 Term 1 (Prep)

Please ensure you discuss with your child the importance of keeping their iPad safe on the way to and from school. Whilst all care is taken, the school does not accept responsibility for an iPad, if it is lost, stolen or damaged.

Preparing for your child to bring their iPad to school:

Repair any damages to the iPad. This includes cracked glass screens.
Create an <u>Apple ID and Password</u> if you don't already have one. Setup Family Sharing (refer to the Required Apps Register for the Setup Process). <i>Please be mindful that this allows ALL photos from your devices to be shared to your child's iPad</i> .
Add a <u>Passcode</u> to your child's iPad (consider setting up <u>Screen Time</u> and <u>uncheck Allow</u> <u>Changes to Passcode</u>). In line with Department of Education Queensland processes for inTune, <u>students will require a passcode to unlock their iPad</u> .
Install and setup the <u>inTune Company Portal app</u> on your child's iPad (refer to the setup process document BYOD MyPad InTune Instructions).
<u>Update your child's iPad</u> to the latest version of iOS. Settings – Software Update.
Check the <u>storage space</u> on your child's iPad and delete photo/video from the camera roll (and recently deleted folder). Go to Settings / General / iPad Storage.
Ensure home apps are saved onto another screen and are kept to a minimum.
Turn off all chat functions including iMessage and app/game notifications.
Ensure mobile data access is not enabled whilst your child is at school.
Your child's name is written on the iPad, in a <u>protective cover</u> , a tempered glass screen
protector (recommended) and water-resistant carry bag sleeve e.g. neoprene (recommended).
Ensure your child has a set of <u>working headphones for school</u> (all students Year 1 – Year 6) and a <u>keyboard</u> (for students in Year 3 – Year 6).
Discuss the MyPad User Agreement with your child.
Read the Department of Education, <u>Cybersafety and Cyberbullying guide for parents and caregivers.</u>

• An Apple ID.


You will need
