1. Check your child’s iPad is 2021 iPad 9th Gen (64GB minimum which is standard) 10.2” Wi-Fi, capable of running the latest iOS software. (*iPad 7 or 8 would be acceptable)	
2. Apple ID: Please ensure that the iPad is set up using your child’s own Apple ID by creating a new icloud email with a variation of their name. This is established through Family Sharing. Please do not establish the iPad with a shared parent Apple ID . We advise that you do not tell your child the Apple ID/Password).	
3. Family Sharing: Correctly creating your child’s own Apple ID will ensure that they are only accessing age-appropriate Apps and content in Safari. This can be done through Apple’s Family Sharing.	
4. Name your child’s iPad Name your child’s iPad with their name Settings > General > About > Name Also, label your child’s iPad case with their name.	
5. Name your child’s Accessories iPad Case with keyboard Headphones Stylus	
6. Add a Lock Screen passcode All 1:1 iPads must have a lock screen passcode. Use thumb print or facial recognition. How to change your passcode on your iPhone, iPad, or iPod ...	
7. Add a Lock Screen photo of your child’s face Adding a photo to the Lock Screen: Take a photo of your child using the Camera App. Tap the “Settings” icon on your iPad’s Home screen to launch the Settings App. Tap “Wallpaper” and then tap “Choose a new wallpaper.” Select “Camera Roll” and select the photo of your child Select “Select Set Lock Screen” Close the Settings App.
