From the Classroom

Curriculum

English:

This term students will explore a variety of different text types as we engage in a range of picture books. Developing speaking, listening and interacting skills will be a focus. Students will work on an *All About Me* project, which they will present to their peers at the end of the term. During phonics and spelling, students will develop their understanding of long vowel patterns, r-influenced vowels (or, ar, ir, er, ur) and other patterns such as oi/oy and ou/ow. Students will practise reading decodable texts and develop their comprehension skills as they listen to narrative texts.

Mathematics:

This term students are learning to represent and interpret data on graphs. They will survey students, record tally marks, represent data and respond to questions. Students will be reading, writing, ordering and representing 3-digit numbers. Skip counting, addition and subtraction will also be a focus.

Science:

During Science, students will investigate combinations of different materials and explore the properties and purposes of these materials. They will be investigating mixtures and predicting how different ingredients affect properties such as taste, texture and colour. Students will use scientific skills and language as they carry out procedures to combine materials to create mixtures.

Humanities and Social Sciences:

Students will begin investigating Geography as they explore *Around The World*. They will be exploring local, national and world maps and using language to describe where places using terms such as near, far, left, right, north, east, south and west. They will be identifying the continents of the world and features such as Northern and Southern Hemisphere. Students will also describe connections they have with places in Australia and overseas, and identify factors that may influence these connections such as distance and location.

Technologies:

In Digital Technologies, students will be learning strategies to keep them safe when using information and digital systems within online environments. They will develop skills using digital systems and technologies, collect a range of data and organise their ideas digitally using iPads.

The Arts:

This term in the Arts, with Miss Orevich, students will be focusing on Music with the theme 'Action Stories'. Students will perform a song about superheroes, arranging the dynamics and body percussion to make an entertaining composition. Students will describe their music using music terminology.

Health and Physical Education:

This Term in Health lessons, our Grade 2 students will be learning about how to keep themselves safe and healthy within a classroom setting and, in the playground, we will look at different strategies to do this.

In Sport, students will learn different skipping techniques and play games using movement to music.

We will also start to learn the course and do some training in preparation for the school Cross Country carnival at the end of the school term on Monday 24th March.

<u>Japanese</u>:In this term, students will listen to Japanese children describing items packed in their schoolbag. They will also demonstrate appropriate greetings and leave-takings when leaving for and arriving at school. Students will analyse and understand the systems of language relating to script recognition. They will participate in intercultural experiences to explore language and routines associated with school preparations and routines in Japan.

Homework

Homework tasks may begin being sent home in around week 5. This may include: sound recognition, counting/skip counting practise and other tasks relevant to our current curriculum content. Home readers will begin as soon as possible. Please let your child's teacher know if you are available to help with changing home readers this year.

Library Borrowing

Your child's teacher will be in contact with if they have any relevant messages regarding Library Borrowing. Please remember, children need to have returned their books from last year to begin borrowing books again.

Excursions

There are no excursions planned for this term. Please check the calendar for important events such as School Photos, Easter Bonnet Parade, Celebration Assessbly and Culminating activities.

Culminating Day

Our Culminating activities will be held during the final week of school each term, following the Celebration Assembly. Parents are encouraged to attend to see the wonderful work the students have been completing throughout the term.
